Benito Müller is Managing Director of Oxford Climate Policy, and Director of the European Capacity Building Initiative (ecbi). At Oxford University he is a Convener International Climate Policy Research at the Environmental Change Institute (ECI), Visiting Professor at the Social Sciences Division, Distinguished Visiting Scholar at the School of Geography and the Environment, and a Member of the Faculty of Philosophy.

Müller received a doctorate in Philosophy from the University of Oxford and was formerly a Research Fellow at Wolfson College and a Lecturer in Logic at the Queen's College, Oxford. He has a Diploma in Mathematics from the Eidgenössische Technische Hochschule (ETH) in Zürich, Switzerland.
